1. The National Association of Schools of Music (NASM) accredits Broward College. Declared music students MUST submit to an audition and advising process in the Visual & Performing Arts Office (4/130) at the beginning of their studies. Those students who declare music as a major, but cannot read music MUST take MUT1001 Fundamentals of Music in order to study music at Broward College. Financial Aid may not cover this course.
2. Additional Requirements: **FSU, FAU, FIU, etc.** all require keyboard proficiency for music majors. Piano students are NOT required to take secondary piano. All other music students are required take secondary piano classes/lessons, which may not be covered by financial aid.
3. Students must successfully meet the foreign language requirement as prescribed in the college catalog. Further, all music students are required to take either German or Italian as a foreign language as per NASM standards.
4. One science lab course is required. The student may choose to take either the Physical or Biological Science lab.
5. Students must take ENC1101, ENC1102, and two additional writing credit courses (6 credits) to graduate.
6. Students must take 3 credits of International/Intercultural coursework to graduate.

** MGF1106 and MGF1107 require a prerequisite of MAT1033, STA1001, or placement by testing
