Career Pathway: Public Safety

Location(s): Courses for this program are offered at all BC locations. Program specific courses for this program are offered at the A. Hugh Adams Central Campus. On occasion, courses may be taught on site at local fire departments. Please consult the course schedule for specific semester locations.

Program Entrance Requirements: HS Diploma or GED. However, the program is recommended for currently employed fire service professionals.

Program Description: The AS degree in Fire Science is designed for fire service or fire protection related professionals to enhance technical competencies and to prepare them for career advancement. The program has courses that help prepare students for state certifications in such areas as Fire Officer, Fire Inspector and Fire Investigator. This AS degree does <u>not</u> qualify students for state certification as a fire fighter. To become certified as a fire fighter, a student must complete an Emergency Medical Technician program and a Florida certified Basic Fire Fighter program (Fire Academy).
