Program Description: The Medical Assisting program is a degree completion option for students who have completed a Medical Assisting College Credit Certificate (CCC) or (PSAV) program. Students who complete a **Medical Assisting Career Certificate Program** from an Institution using the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) Curriculum Frameworks shall receive 44 college credits toward the **Medical Assisting A.S. degree**. Students are also required to complete the Broward College courses listed below. Visit the program's <u>website</u> for more information.

Additional Program Information: Students must complete all required coursework with a grade of "C" or higher and earn a minimum degree grade point average of 2.


