1. Declared Dance students MUST receive advising through the Visual & Performing Arts (V&PA) Department by calling 954-201-6843 or e-mailing Dance@broward.edu at the beginning of their studies.
2. **Dance Appreciation** (DAN2100) counts as a Humanities credit and as a writing credit course.
3. **Dance Repertory** (DAA1680) is a restricted class consisting of performance in a Dance Concert. Students must audition for admittance to this class. For information on audition notices please e-mail Dance@broward.edu.
4. MGF1106 and MGF1107 are general education math courses that do not require prerequisites. MAC1105C is a 5-credit course. Students who register for this course must see an advisor to discuss their academic plan.
5. **Pointe I** (DAA2220) is a restricted elective course and requires departmental approval.
6. Students must take ENC1101, ENC1102 and two additional writing credit courses (6 credits) to graduate.
7. Students may choose any 3-credit general education course in place of Personal Finance (FIN2100).
8. Beginning Fall 2019, first-time in college students must demonstrate competency in civic literacy either through passing POS2041/AMH2020 or CLEP/AP.
9. Students must successfully meet the foreign language requirement as prescribed in the college's policies and procedures 6Hx2-4.22.
10. The Digital Literacy requirement must be met by successfully passing CGS1060C, testing out, or completing a Credit for Prior Learning portfolio. Students that test out are required to take an approved elective to earn the 3 credits. To test out please contact the Testing Center by e-mailing testingservices@broward.edu. Declared Dance Majors are recommended to test out of Digital Literacy to gain 3 elective credits for Dance courses.
11. Core Humanities: Art Appreciation (ARH2000), Intro to Literature (LIT2000), Music Appreciation (MUL2010), Intro to Philosophy (PHI2010), Theatre Appreciation (THE2000), Intro to Humanities (HUM1020).
12. Students must take 3 credits of International/Intercultural coursework to graduate. **Dance Appreciation** (DAN2100) is an international/intercultural course.
