Program Description: The Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree is designed for the student who plans to transition to Broward College's Teacher Education program (2+2) or transfer to a Florida public university as a junior to complete a Bachelor's degree in Education. A student who earns an A.A. degree from Broward College meets the lower division general education requirements of a Florida state university, but does not automatically meet the requirements for a particular major.

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- Students seeking a Bachelor's degree in Teacher Education are required to pass the General Knowledge Exam (GKE). Students should register for the exam upon completion of their required Mathematics and English courses. EDG1006 is a GKE preparation course which counts as an elective course toward A.A. completion.
- Students interested in majoring in Elementary Education please discuss with your assigned advisor the option of transitioning into the Teacher Education Program in ESE K-12 at BC.
