

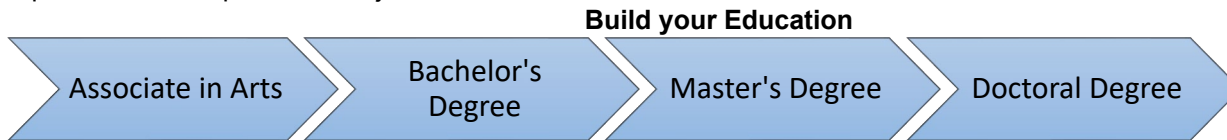


## Geography (B.A.) Transfer Plan – Associate of Arts 1010

**Program Description:** The Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree is designed for the student who plans to transfer to a Florida public university as a junior to complete a Bachelor's degree. A student who earns an A.A. degree from Broward College meets the lower division general education requirements of a Florida state university, but does not automatically meet the requirements for a particular major.

- D. Student may choose to take either the POS2041 (National Government) or AMH2020 (American History Since 1865) to satisfy the state civic literacy requirement.
- E. EVR1001 and EVR1001L Introduction to environmental Science + Lab strongly suggested for FIU and FAU.
- F. Completion of AA degree and GIS1040, GIS1042, GIS1030 and GIS1047, students will earn the GIS ATC
- G. Strongly suggest INR2002 to satisfy Foundations in Global Citizenship requirement and GEO2200 for Geography majors for FAU.
- H. The Digital Literacy requirement must be met by either taking CGS1060C or testing out. To test out please contact the Testing Center by e-mailing [testingservices@broward.edu](mailto:testingservices@broward.edu). Students who meet the Digital Literacy requirement and therefore do not need to take CGS1060C are required to take an elective. GEO2200 or a GIS course is strongly recommended.
