# ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES (EAP)

The English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program prepares non-native speakers of English for academic study in certificate and degree programs at U.S. colleges and universities. The program consists of ten courses in three skill areas: Grammar and Writing; Listening and Speaking; and Reading and Vocabulary.

Students take a placement test to determine their course level. After successfully completing the EAP program, students may enroll in an academic course of study at Broward College and many other Florida state colleges without providing TOEFL or IELTS scores. In addition, students enrolled in some academic programs may be able to earn college credits for specific courses within the EAP program.

## IN THIS PROGRAM, YOU WILL

- Develop the academic language skills needed to succeed in college, university, and professional settings.
- Learn academic reading, writing, grammar, listening, and speaking skills to be successful in college and university level coursework for the purposes of career specialization.
- Develop the critical thinking and analytical skills required in U.S. colleges and universities.
- Learn to write essays, read academic texts, understand lectures, and make presentations.

## (NON-CREDIT)

The Intensive English Program courses in the Workforce and Continuing Education department are ideal for anyone seeking to improve their language skills for personal and/or professional reasons. The courses include Intensity English I, II, and III, Grammar for ESL, and Writing for ESL. These courses cater to all levels of English Language Learners – beginning from Zero English. The Continuing Education Department offers a self-assessment online to assist students in selecting the appropriate level. Classes are between 6-8 weeks long and are conveniently offered in the evening and online.

In addition, the Adult ESOL program is designed to lead to the attainment of a secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent and transition to postsecondary education and training; or employment.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 16 years or older
- Not enrolled or required to be enrolled in secondary school
- Does not have a high school diploma or its equivalent
- Wants to learn to speak, read, and write the English language
