FOR POLICE SERVICE AIDE GRADUATES

Students who successfully complete the Broward College Police Service Aide Academy are eligible to receive 3 college credits from Broward College. To receive the credits you must:

 Have passed all aspects of the Broward College Police Service Aide Academy

The 3 college credits will be awarded as "prior learning assessment" (experiential learning - life experience) credits (no cost!). They will be for the following course:

CCJ 2949 Co Op Work Experience (3 credits)

Depending on your selected degree major, this course may be counted toward an Associate degree earned at Broward College. It will appear on your transcript as "CR" (credit awarded), but no grade is given and there is no impact on your G.P.A. (grade point average). If you wish to transfer these courses to another college or university, consult with that school to see if it will accept prior learning assessment (experiential learning) credits and the "CR" grade.
