Firearms Instructor Update



Course Description:

This 24-hour course provides the mandatory training and overview of changes made to the Florida Basic Recruit Training (BRT) Program Criminal Justice Firearms Course and the Firearms Instructor Course. Participants must furnish their agency approved handgun, loading devices, handheld flashlight, gun belt accessories, and **500 non-frangible rounds**. Participants are required to wear body armor on the range.

Course Objectives:

At the end of this program, students will:

- Identify the significant changes to the Basic Recruit Training and Criminal Justice Firearms Course content and performance requirements.
- Demonstrate the new firearms stance and position as well as the new flashlight techniques.
- Explain the importance of loading, unloading, and reloading in the workspace.
- Identify the purpose and requirements for each handgun proficiency evaluation and qualification.
- Identify considerations when responding alone to active threat and shooter incidents.
- Identify the Basic Recruit Training, Criminal Justice Firearms textbook content regarding active threat and shooter incidents.
- Identify the purpose and objectives of the mandatory Active Threat/Shooter Drills.

End of Course Examination: CJSTC Rule 11b35.001 9(b): A student enrolled in a Specialized Instructor Training Course shall achieve a score of no less than 85% on the written end-of-course examination, exclusive of demonstration of any proficiency skills.

Attendance: Attendance at the initial class is mandatory. All students must adhere to the attendance requirements of the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission and the Rules, Policies and Procedures of the Institute of Public Safety

Dress Policy: Your department's authorized training uniform. Law enforcement personnel not in uniform that are carrying exposed firearms must prominently display agency ID and/or badge at all times while on college property.
