**Location:** General program requirements, including seminar workshops are available on the Broward North and South campus. Pathway courses are offered on a BC location as specified by the Pathway program.

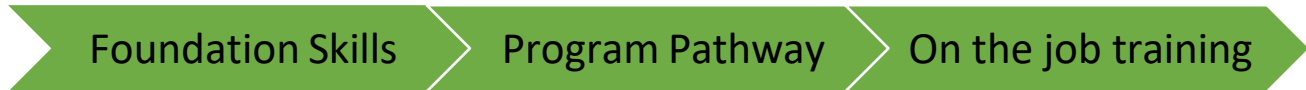
**Program Entrance requirements:** HS diploma or equivalency, diagnosed intellectual disability and acceptance into the Seahawk NEST Academy.

**Program Description:**

Seahawk NEST Academy is a three-year program offered at Broward College to prepare students with an intellectual disability to complete an individualized, vocational and technical-based curriculum. Students earn the Broward College Certificate of Professional Services by completing the following components of the program:

- **Complete the 37 Broward College classes in the three-year program as listed in the table below.**
- Complete the 14 units of Foundation workshops listed below
- Complete a virtual portfolio that reflects course work, skill attainment, and work readiness.
- Maintain good standing with Broward College and the Seahawk NEST Academy.
