Program Entrance requirements: HS diploma or equivalency, diagnosed intellectual disability and acceptance into the Seahawk NEST Academy.

Program Description:

Seahawk NEST Academy is a three-year program offered at Broward College to prepare students with an intellectual disability to complete an individualized, vocational and technical-based curriculum. Students earn the Broward College Certificate of Professional Services by completing the following components of the program:

- Complete the 37 Broward College classes in the three-year program as listed in the table below.
- Complete the 14 units of Foundation workshops listed below
- Complete a virtual portfolio that reflects course work, skill attainment, and work readiness.
- Maintain good standing with Broward College and the Seahawk NEST Academy.
