Voucher for Excellence

BRACE Advisors & Guidance Counselors,

The Voucher for Excellence covers the full cost of tuition at Broward College not to exceed 64 credits per student, up to 30 credits per academic year – a value of over \$7,500.00. Two graduating seniors could be eligible from each Broward County Public High school depending on when nominations are submitted and availability of funding. Only a BRACE advisor or Guidance Counselor is permitted to nominate a student to receive this award. It is encouraged to nominate students that have chosen Broward College as their first-choice college.

In order to be eligible for the Voucher for Excellence, the nominee must:

- Have a minimum 3.0 high school GPA (unweighted).
- Have applied to Broward College and declared a major on the application.
- Submit required documents to the Office of Admissions to prove in-state residency for tuition purposes.
- Submit proof of high school graduation to the Office of Admissions.
- Complete a 2019-2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov.

Note that nominees are only eligible to receive one Broward Voucher.

To nominate a student, the BRACE Advisor or Guidance Counselor must:

- Visit www.broward.edu/financialaid.
- Click on “Forms” on the left navigation menu.
- Click on the “High School Outreach” tab.
- Complete and submit the electronic “Voucher for Excellence” nomination form.
