

# English for Academic Purposes (EAP) Flowchart

EAP students will test only with ACCUPLACER ESL/LOEP for both placement and college readiness assessment. After the initial test date, a student may re-test 1 time after 24 hours from the initial test date within a 12 month period for a retest fee. Additional re-testing requires de-partment approval. Students may request a Listening/Speaking evaluation from the department. Effective June 1, 2022, EAP students are no longer eligible to take ACCUPLACER NG or PERT for the reading and writing subtests. EAP students are eligible to take the math subtest if student scores into, or is currently enrolled in, EAP0420C. EAP courses require a passing grade of 'C' or higher.

## Level 1

### Combined Skills EAP0182C (9 credits)

A beginner course that addresses English grammar, writing, reading, speaking, listening, and vocabulary skills.

## Level 2

### Combined Skills EAP0282C (9 credits)

A high-beginner course that addresses English grammar, writing, reading, speaking, listening, and vocabulary skills.

Write Placer ESL = 2

Listening: 58-70

Reading: 60-74

## Level 3

### LISTENING/SPEAKING 3

EAP 0300C (3 Credits)

Prerequisite: EAP0200C or EAP0281C or EAP0282C

An intermediate course that emphasizes the development of speaking, listening, and pronunciation skills.

LOEP = 71-85

## Level 3

### READING 3

EAP 0320C (3 Credits)

Prerequisite: EAP0220C or EAP0281C or EAP0282C

An intermediate course that emphasizes vocabulary, literal and critical comprehension and study skills.

LOEP = 75-89

## Level 3

### GRAMMAR/WRITING 3

EAP 0385C (6 Credits)

Prerequisite: EAP0285C or EAP0281C or EAP0282C

An intermediate course that emphasizes sentence construction, question formation, grammar structures, & paragraph formation.

LOEP = 3

## Level 4

### LISTENING/SPEAKING 4

EAP 0400C (3 Credits)

Prerequisite: EAP0300C

A high-intermediate course that emphasizes the development of speaking, listening, and pronunciation skills. Exempt: 101-120

LOEP = 86-100

## Level 4

### READING 4

EAP 0420C (3 Credits)

Prerequisite: EAP0320C

A high-intermediate course that emphasizes vocabulary, literal and critical comprehension and study skills.

LOEP = 90-113

## Level 4

### GRAMMAR/WRITING 4

EAP 0485C (6 Credits)

Prerequisite: EAP0385C

A high-intermediate course that emphasizes paragraph writing and mastery of complex grammatical structures.

LOEP = 4



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## Level 5

### READING 5

EAP 1520C (3 Credits) Prerequisite: EAP0420C

Recommended: EAP0400C & 0485C  
An advanced course that emphasizes vocabulary skills, inferential and critical comprehension, and analytical reading strategies. Exempt: 119-120

LOEP = 114-118

## Level 5

### WRITING 5

EAP 1540C (3 Credits)

Prerequisites: EAP0485C, EAP0400C & EAP0420C

An advanced composition course that addresses mastery of paragraph writing, effective editing skills, and provides an introduction to essay development.

LOEP = 5

## ENC1101

### Eligibility for ENC 1101

Students can complete the EAP program to place into ENC 1101

or

Students **MUST** score in range on **ALL** LOEP subtests below:

ESL Reading = 119-120

ESL Listening: 101-120

ESL Language Use: 117-120

WritePlacer ESL = 6 or 99

Check test scores for ENC 1101 eligibility.  
Placement into ENC 1101 based on LOEP scores is not automatic.

EAP students who score below ENC1101 are not eligible for Dev Ed courses (i.e. ENC 0017C). Students remain in EAP.

## Level 6

### WRITING 6

EAP 1640C (3 Credits)

Prerequisite: EAP1540C

An advanced composition course which focuses on the writing process, essay development, and academic research.

Exempt: 99

LOEP = 6

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
