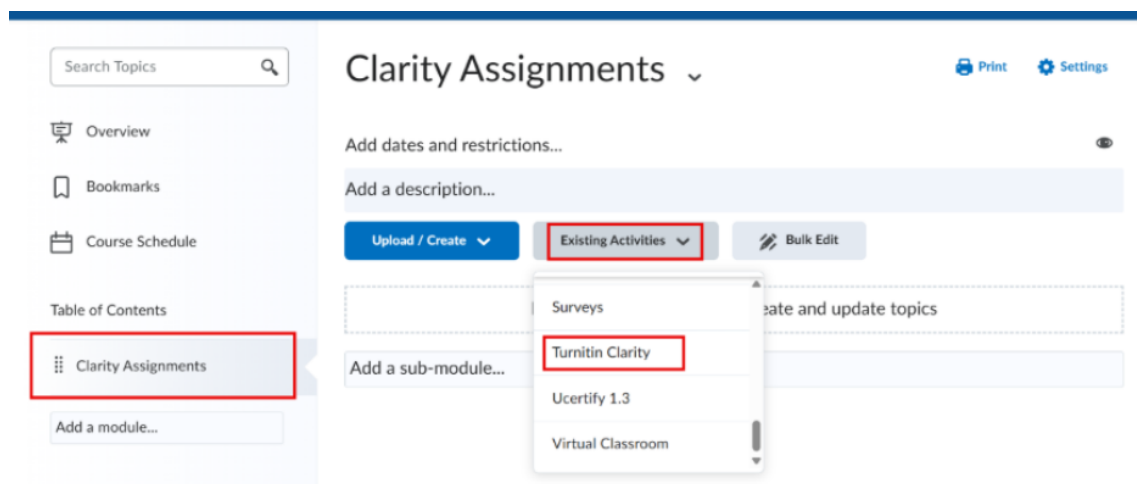


Enabling Turnitin Clarity in D2L Brightspace (Classic)

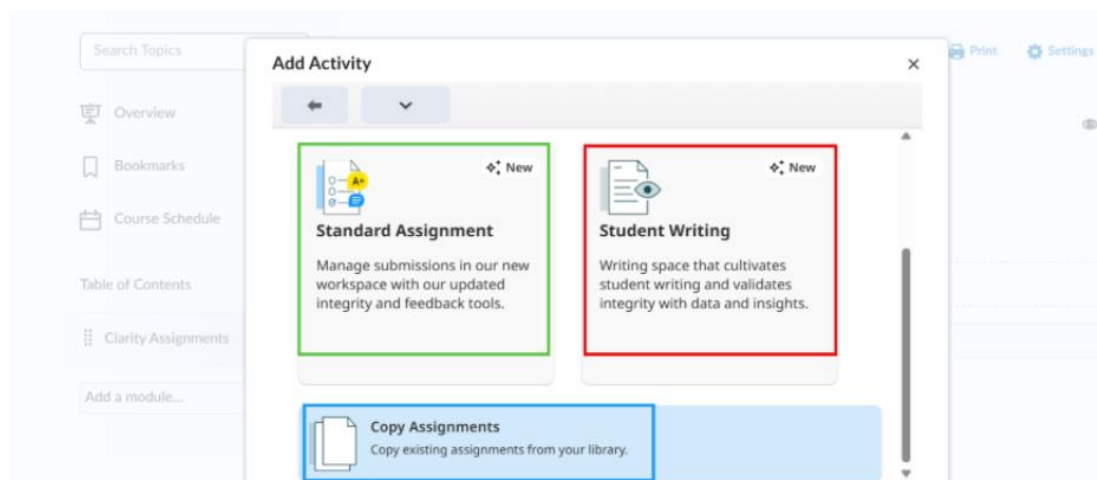
Setting up and managing Turnitin Clarity

Unlike standard Turnitin assignments, **Turnitin Clarity** is **not** available from the **Assignments** tool. Instead, it must be added through a **Content** module.

1. In **D2L Classic**, click **Content** from the blue navigation bar.
2. Create a new module or open an existing module. (can be named based on instructor preferences)
3. Click on **Existing Activities**.

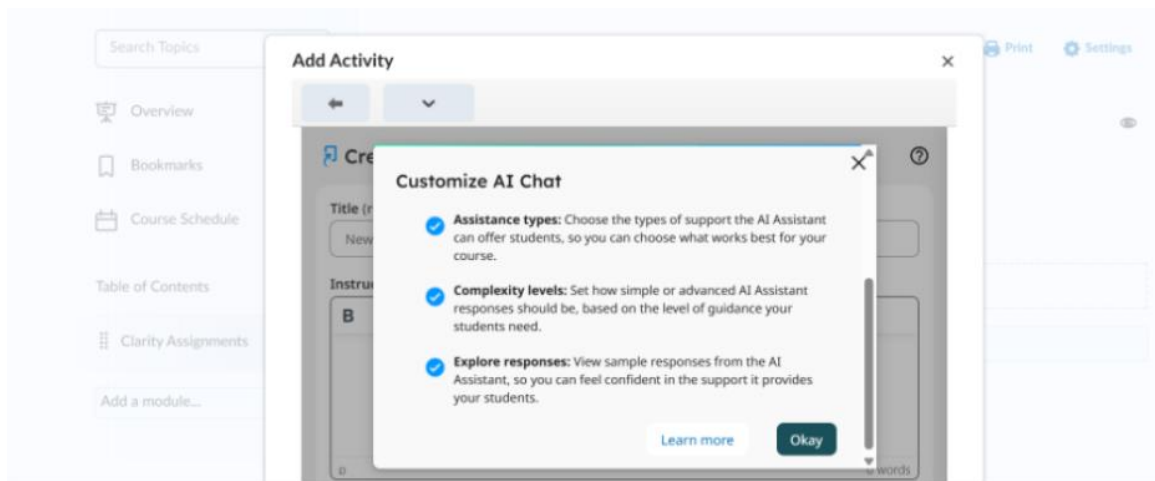


4. From the menu, select **Turnitin Clarity**
5. Configure the assignment settings based on your preferences.



6. Choose one of the following assignment types:

- a. **Standard Turnitin Assignment** – Includes Similarity and AI Writing reports. This assignment type is also available through the **Assignments** tool.
- b. **Student Writing Space** – Available only through **Turnitin Clarity LTI within the Module**. This option provides instructors with additional insights into the student's writing process, including a version of history and writing activity.



7. You can also copy Turnitin Clarity assignments from previous course offerings to reuse them in a new course.

Instructor Note: Before assigning a Student Writing assignment, clearly communicate your expectations for how students should use the writing space. Student Writing is designed to capture the student's writing process, so encourages students to complete their drafting and revisions within the Clarity writing space whenever possible, rather than composing the assignment elsewhere and pasting it in at the end. If you enable Turnitin's AI tools, be sure to explain your course expectations for appropriate AI use. AI assistance is optional and can be enabled or disabled on a per-assignment basis at the instructor's discretion. Students should always follow your course and institutional policies regarding AI use.

Grading Turnitin Clarity Assignments

Grading is completed within the Turnitin Clarity assignment. From the Content area, click the assignment title to open it, then view and evaluate student submissions. If the assignment was configured as a graded activity, the score entered in Turnitin Clarity will automatically sync to the corresponding grade item in the D2L gradebook.
