



- Accessible Admissions Process
- No TOEFL/IELTS/Duolingo Required
- Affordability
- Catered Academic Advising







Transfer Student Rights

- Students who graduate from an FCS school with an AA degree are guaranteed
 - Admissions to an upper division program at a state university
 - Acceptance of at least 60 semester hours
 - Transfer of equivalent courses
 - Acceptance of dual enrollment, CLEP, AP, IB, AICE credits
 - No additional general education requirements





AA Transfer Requirements

- Applicants are required to have successfully completed a minimum of 67% of all credit hours attempted at currently and previously enrolled institutions.
- With an Associate of Arts (AA) from a Florida College System institution
 - Transfer GPA \geq 2.0





Foreign Language Requirement (FLENT)

- Students must have completed two academic units of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language or American Sign Language (ASL) in college to be considered for admission.
- Students who have not met FLENT at point of admission are still admissible but must meet FLENT before graduating from USF.

Admissions to SUS but not degree

- Many programs have pre-requisites
 - College of Engineering at USF you must have grades on transcripts
 - Muma College of Business classes can be in-progress
- Many programs also have GPA requirements

Statewide Course Numbering System

- Now used at all 12 state universities, 28 Florida College System Institutions. (Also at 38 participating nonpublic postsecondary & 48 Career Education Centers)
- Exceptions at discretion of the receiving university:
 - Courses not offered by receiving institution
 - Courses in the 900-999 series such as Special Topics, Internships, Apprenticeships, Study Abroad, Thesis and Dissertations
 - College prep and vocations (remedial English courses)
 - Graduate courses
 - Applied courses in performing arts and skilled courses in criminal justice.





Credit-by-Exam

- USF allows students to receive up to 45 semester hours of credit towards the baccalaureate degree upon successful completion of any of the examinations listed below:
- Advanced International Certificate of Education
- Advanced Placement
- <u>Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Exams</u>
- <u>College Level Examination Program</u>
- <u>Defense Language Proficiency Test</u>
- DSST (formerly DANTES Subject Standardized Tests)
- Excelsior
- General Certificate of Education
- German Abitur
- <u>Global Assessment Certificate</u>
- International Baccalaureate









Challenges for admissions offices

- Southern Hemisphere Schools
 - Especially students applying for Fall
- Non-EDI transcripts
 - Means we have to manually key the courses vs. receiving them electronically – slows down the admissions process
- Not knowing they are from a Broward International Campus vs. onshore Broward campus



Steps to Apply

STEP 1 Complete and submit application online at admissions.usf.edu/intl-apply

STEP 2 Pay the \$30 application fee

STEP 3 Review our website for specific requirements based on student type.

Please note: Transfer application requirements may vary by program.

STEP 4 Submit your official college or university transcripts

STEP 5 English proficiency based on grade 'C' or higher in ENC 1101 or equivalent OR TOEFL 79+ Duolingo 110+ IELTS 6.5+ PTEA 53+
