Remote FCLE Process

 - Audio and video need to be active in Zoom on the Proctor computer
 - Video needs to be active on student computer in TIDE
- A local proctor must be present during the entire test



Testing Room - Stations - Proctor Desk

The testing room is kept locked at all times. Access is granted during testing, and for cleaning purposes by authorized personnel only. It has the following common characteristics:

- ✓ Single point monitored entry and exit to test room.
- ✓ Ability to maintain visual contact with testing students at all times.
- ✓ Acoustics that do not amplify sounds.
- ✓ Climate control that can be adjusted from the test area.
- ✓ Lighting suitable for extended periods of use.
- ✓ Sufficient space between test stations for examinee comfort and exam security.
- ✓ Bathroom facilities located nearby.
- ✓ Water fountain located nearby

Students are placed 3.0 feet away from each other during testing, to maintain sufficient safe distance. We can take a maximum of 2 students at each sitting,

All testing guidelines are posted in the front of the room, and next to the testing stations

After sitting at their assigned desk, the students will receive pencils and scratch papers.

Our stations/equipment will be only used for testing purposes.

All laptops require log-in information and possess website-blocking software to prevent access to unauthorized websites during testing.

A separate area outside the testing room is provided for students to keep their belongings before entering the testing room. Students are only allowed to carry their photo ID, wallet, and key to the provided locker, while taking the test.
