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# Articulation Agreements

- Types of Articulation Agreements
  - Florida 2+2 Articulation Agreement
    - Students who graduate from an institution within the Florida College System with an Associate of Arts degree are guaranteed admission to **one** of the 12 state universities, except to limited access programs



# Articulation Agreements

- Types of Articulation Agreements
  - Internal Associates to Bachelors Agreements
    - AA/AS Degree to Bachelor's of Applied Science (BAS)
      - Supervision and Management
      - Information Technology
      - Technology Management
      - Supply Chain Management
    - AA Degree to Bachelor's of Science in Education
    - AS in Nursing to Bachelor's of Science in Nursing
    - AA/AS to Bachelor's of Science in Environmental Science



# Articulation Agreements

## □ Types of Articulation Agreements

### ■ External Articulation Agreement

#### ■ General

- Any associates degree to any bachelor's degree
- Any associates degree to a specific bachelor's degree
  - Private/Out-of-State

#### ■ Program Specific

- Specific AA or AS degree to a specific bachelor's degree
- Specific AA or AS degree, including specific courses, to a specific bachelor's degree

  - Purpose Statement
  - Conditions of Admissions
  - Responsibilities of Institutions
    - Advising Responsibilities
    - Marketing Efforts
  - General Terms and Conditions
    - Legal document
  - Curriculum Matrix – Course Equivalence

# Articulation Agreements

- Process for Articulation Agreement Development
  - Either party can initiate interest
  - Initial conversation with AVP and Director of Academic Affairs
    - Curriculum meeting/discussion with faculty from both institutions
      - Academic Affairs sends curriculum information electronically
  - Partnering institution sends draft agreement
  - Final agreement is sent to the BC Provost and Senior Vice President of Academic Affairs for signature
  - Director of Academic Affairs sends copies of signed agreement to partnering institution for signature(s)
