- Faculty credentials is THE MOST COMMONLY CITED AREA FOR NON-COMPLIANCE in a SACS review- roughly 90% of institutions are cited.



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# Zero Tolerance for Non-Compliance

 IF EVEN ONE FACULTY MEMBER AT A BC INTERNATIONAL CENTER IS OUT OF COMPLIANCE, THE ENTIRE INSTITUTION IS OUT OF COMPLIANCE






