The main activities are agricultural and lumber production



Exploration Phase



Selection of Broward College

- June 2010-Board of Directors of the Santa Cruz Cooperative School started to explore the idea of offering a 2 year USA College Program on campus.
- School Director was invited to attend the Broward College Latin American Cumbre held in Lima in June 2011.
- Decision was made to start initial contacts with Broward College. David Moore was invited to visit Bolivia in March 2012.



Broward College was chosen as the best option for Bolivia.






Type of Institution

The decision was made to create a university in Santa Cruz that would function as a support for Broward College:

- * Board of Directors wanted a university that would be independent of local school and university political issues.
- * The Board is composed of individuals who have a high regard for education and willing to invest in a long-term project.


Creation Phase






Site Selection Process
