## GENERAL STATEMENT

Pursuant to Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) principle 4.2.g (*Board Self-Evaluation*), the District Board of Trustees is required to define and regularly evaluate its responsibilities and expectations. This policy addresses the self-evaluation as a duty of the District Board of Trustees of Broward College.

- A summary of the evaluation results will be presented and discussed by all members of the Board.
