- Passport copy
- Community College or University Transcript
- Associates Degree from US Community College or 2.00+ GPA on Composition I & II sequence or English proficiency score

# Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship (PTK)

Transfer students with a minimum of 24 transferable credits may be eligible for the Transfer Merit Award and the Northwest International Achievement Scholarship if their transferable grade-point average (GPA) is the following:

Amount: \$3,500 Deadline: Feb. 1

- Must be a member of PTK
- 42 transferable completed credits from U.S. community college
- 3.50 cumulative GPA

## **Transfer Merit Awards**

Transfer students with a minimum of 24 transferable credits may be eligible for the Transfer Merit Award and the Northwest International Achievement Scholarship if their transferable grade-point average (GPA) is the following:

3.00-3.29 transferable GPA: \$1,000 per year

3.30-3.49 transferable GPA: \$1,500 per year

3.50-4.00 transferable GPA: \$2,500 per year
