- Must have cumulative college GPA of 3.25 or higher.

  - ◊ Entrepreneurship and Innovation
  - ◊ Finance
  - ◊ General Business
  - ◊ International Business
  - ◊ Management
  - ◊ Marketing
- Amounts based on full-time status (12 credit hours or more).
- Students must renew their application **EVERY YEAR.**
- For first consideration, please apply by: **FEBRUARY 15th.**
